From the President

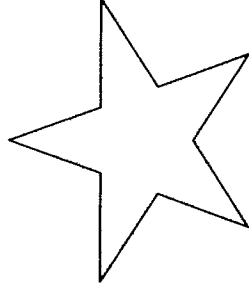
